Litter and Dumping

Litter Management Plans or Litter Control Strategies

This initiative is a cornerstone of the village's approach to environmental stewardship and litter control, underscoring a community-wide commitment to sustainability and respect for our surroundings.

Key Aspects of the Take Your Litter Home Policy:
